Discussion

As the memory verse stated, there is a measure of faith given to every believer, however, you are responsible for the growth and develop of the measure you possess. There are certain degrees at which your faith operates in a particular area. Your faith can be weak in one area, strong in another, or even nonexistent. The growth of your faith is dependent upon you not God. Oftentimes believers miss out on what rightfully belongs to them because they lack the faith to receive what the Word says is already theirs. Romans 4:20 in the Amplified Bible tells us that Abraham “grew strong” in faith; this gives the impression that his faith didn’t start off strong. Notice he grew his faith. Anything you spend time developing will grow. This is why reading, meditating, speaking and listening to the Word of God is so important. In reading about the miracles during the ministry of Jesus, He would often tell the individual that needed healing “according to your faith be it unto you.” Unless there was a Gift of the Spirit in manifestation, their faith was required in bringing about the miracle. No matter what level your faith is on, about a particular subject, you can develop it to become strong and productive.
